

We Have Relocated!

In our last correspondence, we reported that we have been in search for a new location as our seven years at Valley Brook Community Church Campus had ended, we felt the shift and it was time to step out in faith to build the dream that God put on our hearts at the founding of F.U.S.E, but where?

As we sought the Lord in this time of transition, it became very clear by March/April that we were to take a road trip on an invitation of a supporter of F.U.S.E who moved to the Wilmington area in 2016. She help place our first mom who was living in the woods into Nehemiah House within a week of opening. She is once again instrumental by connecting us with Roots of Recovery organization who provides housing and support to women and women with children.

At our first meeting, the founder was direct that she was exploring ways to pass the baton to another. She extended an invitation to come build a pre-approved 20+ tiny house community on their property. They had acquired five acres over a few years purchasing tracts of land connected to each other that includes two refurbished mobile homes, a single dwelling and a few outbuildings. We were asked to either acquire it from them or merge to build it together.

We spent time investigating what this would entail and what resources are available to us if we should respond to this invitation.

This process opened the door to what we believe was a God ordained connection with not only [One Christian Network](#) with founder Emma Baltezare who introduced us to many service providers and resources but also [Eden Village of Wilmington](#). Eden Village is a 31-unit tiny home community specially designed to provide permanent homes for chronically homeless individuals including patients of the local hospital. Their motto is “Imagine a city where no one sleeps outside.”

We stepped out in faith and with the unanimous board’s approval we listed our multi-family home in Granby Ct. Within nine days, we had multiple offers at over asking and closed on July 29th. By the grace of God, the surplus from the sale will help us to begin constructing a few tiny homes.

Our desire is to have the prototype we believe the Lord has given us that can be replicated to bring back to the northeast and beyond. Again, North Carolina has in place the community, resources and the zoning to pave the way.

We are beyond grateful for your unwavering support for years, entrusting us with the call to care for women in crisis to see their lives transformed by the Love of Christ.

We are reaching out to all our partners to share where the Lord is leading us and asking that you continue to partner with us whether through prayer or financial support. We are deeply humbled in this next assignment.
